Technocrats4ED is established as a professional technical affiliate of ZANU PF, dedicated to the industrial modernization of the Republic of Zimbabwe.

The organization is founded in full alignment with the visionary leadership of the President and First Secretary of ZANU PF, **Cde. Dr. E.D. Mnangagwa**. We recognize his strategic foresight in placing science and technology at the center of national development and we adopt the transformative mandate of **Vision 2030** as the foundational pillar for all our technical endeavors.

Driven by the national philosophy, "**Nyika inovakwa nevene vayo**," Technocrats4ED serves as a structured platform for patriotic technocrats, innovators, and artisans both at home and within our strategic global clusters in the People's Republic of China and other industrial zones to deploy their expertise for the nation's benefit. We are committed to the principle of "**Leaving No One Behind**," ensuring that the move toward a high-tech economy is inclusive, democratic, and leads to the ultimate technological sovereignty of Zimbabwe.



## ARTICLE 1: NAME AND SLOGANS

1.1 The name of the organization shall be Technocrats4ED / T4ED.

1.2 **Motto:** *"Innovating for the People: Global Expertise, Local Industrialization."*

1.2 The official slogans shall be:

- ***"Pamberi neZANU PF!"***
- ***"Pamberi neKuvaka Nyika!"***
- ***"Technocrats4ED: Innovating for the People!"***
- ***"Technocrats4ED : Bridging Global Expertise and Local Industrialization: Building the Future Together."***
- ***"Nyika inovakwa nevene vayo!"***

## ARTICLE 2: AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

2.1 To mobilize all Zimbabweans with technical, industrial, and scientific skills—regardless of formal academic qualifications to support the ZANU PF developmental agenda.

2.2 To leverage the **Diaspora Technical Vanguard** in high-tech zones (like China) for the direct transfer of industrial resources, machinery, and advanced intellectual property (IP) to Zimbabwe.

2.3 To move beyond mere "technology transfer" to the **indigenous development** of high-tech solutions in AI, robotics, green energy, and advanced manufacturing.

2.4 To promote the **Education 5.0** philosophy by bridging the gap between university innovation hubs and market-ready industrial production.

2.5 To ensure that Zimbabwe's technological revolution remains anchored in patriotic values and serves the masses.

2.6 To provide technical advisory and "Technical Intelligence" to the Party and Government on scientific and industrial matters.

2.7 To utilize the unique positioning of Diaspora technocrats who have direct access to advanced manufacturing resources, research funding, and global scientific networks for the benefit of local industrialization.

2.8 To provide a home for all technical talents, valuing proven innovative capacity and artisans alongside academic excellence.

## ARTICLE 3: MEMBERSHIP AND INCLUSIVITY

**3.1 Open Membership:** Membership is open to all Zimbabweans who subscribe to the principles and goals of the Vision 2030.

**3.2 The "Leave No One Behind" Clause:** Eligibility is based on **Technical Competency** rather than just formal degrees. Membership is categorized as:

- **Tier1 (Individual):** Professionals, researchers, self-taught innovators, students, and skilled artisans.
- **Tier2 (Corporate):** Tech-driven startups and industrial firms committed to local value addition.
- **Tier 3 (Institutional):** Research centers, innovation hubs, and technical colleges.

**3.3 Affiliation Requirement:** While membership is inclusive, all members of the **Executive** must hold a valid ZANU PF membership card.

## ARTICLE 4: GOVERNANCE AND LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE

**4.1 The Diaspora Mandate:** To ensure the organization remains at the forefront of global technological trends, the positions of **National Chairperson**, **Secretary for Strategic Technology Transfer**, and **Secretary for Diaspora High-Tech Clusters** shall be reserved for members currently based in the Diaspora, specifically within recognized high-tech industrial zones (e.g., the People's Republic of China).

**4.2 The Home-Based Secretariat:** To ensure seamless implementation and liaison with the Party and Government, the **Vice National Chairperson**, **Secretary General**, and **National Political Commissar** shall be based in Zimbabwe.

**4.3 Democratic Elections:** All positions shall be filled through democratic elections by the general membership. However, the Proponent shall serve as the **Interim Chairperson** during the foundational phase to establish the international pipeline.

## **ARTICLE 5: THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE (NEC)**

The NEC shall consist of the following interim positions:

- 1. National Chairperson (Diaspora-Based)**
- 2. Vice National Chairperson (Home-Based)**
- 3. Secretary General & Legal Affairs**
- 4. National Treasurer**
- 5. National Political Commissar & Publicity**
- 6. Secretary for Strategic Technology Transfer (Diaspora-Based)**
- 7. Secretary for Inclusive Talent & Special Groups**
- 8. Secretary for Innovation & Industrialization (Education 5.0 Liaison)**
- 9. Secretary for ICT & Digital Transformation**

## **ARTICLE 6: AFFILIATION AND SUPREMACY**

**6.1** Technocrats4ED is an affiliate of ZANU PF and shall be subject to the supremacy of the Party.

**6.2** This Constitution and all activities of the organization shall be consistent with the ZANU PF Constitution.

## **ARTICLE 7: SPECIAL PROJECT COMMISSIONS**

**7.1** Diaspora Technical Taskforce: The NEC shall have the power to appoint specialized taskforces comprised of Diaspora members to lead high-impact national projects in fields such as AI, robotics, green energy, and advanced manufacturing.

**7.2** Institutional Bridging: The organization shall facilitate formal "twining" arrangements between Zimbabwean technical institutions and the high-tech firms or industrial zones where our members are currently embedded abroad.
